It is the goal of the ADS picture project to obtain a quality picture of every dahlia defined in the Online Classification and Handbook of Dahlias. **Please Note:** After visiting any link in this document, use your browser's back arrow to return to this document.

Even though most of us are not "professional" photographers, we don't need to be. Just view some of the existing pictures.

The emphasis will be on dahlias that currently have **no picture online**.


Next, emphasis will be on dahlias that have pictures but could be improved upon

Finally, the ADS encourages submission of pictures for *any dahlia*, defined online, even if the current picture is good, very good, even great.

If you feel you have a "better" picture, by all means, please submit it!

The ideal photograph will have a single bloom predominant and the **entire bloom** in the picture (**not partially cut off**). ---->

Please photograph with a **landscape** orientation (horizontal dimension is significantly greater than vertical dimension). ---->



Please turn off date imprint on your camera.

Do not overtype comments of any kind on the picture; no copyright statements, no bloom name, no classification info or photographer name, none of that.

Just the picture of the dahlia(s).

Please:

- 1) Send your pictures, as photographed. The ADS will perform all necessary cropping and sizing functions.
- 2) Name your pictures with the dahlia name spelled exactly as it appears on the online Classification and Handbook of Dahlias.
- 3) E-Mail your pictures (not more than approximately 10 megabytes in total, per e-Mail).
